




NH HOTEL***, GRANDES PLACES 14, CH-1700 FRIBOURG



The hotel, a convention and business center, is located in the city center of Fribourg, 10 minutes from the highway exit. It is close to Berne (35 km), Geneva (140 km), Zurich (155 km), Gruyère (30 km), Murten (15 km), Interlaken (95 km) and Montreux (60 km).

The NH hotel is within walking distance (300 m) of the railway station.



LET US HAVE A LOOK AT FRIBOURG....




Nestled in the heart of Switzerland, Fribourg has something for everyone... the medieval splendour of its historic old town, the buzz of the modern-day city and its dynamic student community, a thriving and diverse arts scene, some of the most exquisite gourmet restaurants in Europe and, last but by no means least, a breathtaking landscape just waiting to be explored.






In Fribourg, the canton's capital and economic centre, you'll find a cultural treasure trove that goes back to the Middle Ages. The city is known for its cultural plurality, university, many gourmet restaurants and bridges over the River Sarine that links the French-speaking and German-speaking part of Switzerland.

To fully appreciate the beauty of Fribourg, you have to see it from up high, from either the tower of Saint Nicholas's Cathedral, or the Gate of Bourguillon. The view of this major European architectural ensemble, a part of the Middle Ages that has survived modernity, is unforgettable. The city was founded in 1157 by Duke Berthold IV of Zaehringen. This city of art is also a city of studies, owing to its university. It is also known for the congresses which it hosts.





Founded in 1157 by Duke Berthold IV of Zaehringen and sheltered from the ravages of history, Fribourg is an important volume in the complete set of Western civilization and its old town, one of the biggest Medieval architectural ensembles in Europe. Wherever you go, wherever you look, you come across a surprise, make your way through the centuries, architecture from the past and other objects made by traditional handcrafts as well as modern work.



Fribourg is a city that preserves its past and remains open to the future. Art and History have woven a bond of love in Fribourg. Eight centuries of artistic creation have shaped its prestige, perpetuated by many contemporary artists such as Jean Tinguely whose works have gained international acclaim.


